What Are Cookies

As is common practice with almost all professional websites this site uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer, to improve your experience. This page describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored however this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality.

What files do we use?

At www.meetback.io we use two basic types of cookies divided by time:

- **Session cookies** - temporary files that remain stored in your browser only until you close it.
- **Persistent cookies** - files that remain stored on your device until you manually delete them.
- None of the above types is used to collect personal information and it is therefore not possible to identify the user according to cookies.

According to the function that cookies perform on our website, we divide them into:

- **Conversion** - used to evaluate the performance of individual sales channels.
- **Tracking** - in combination with conversion, they are used to analyze sales channels and help us improve the user experience.
- **Analytical** - help us to understand the behavior of visitors to our site.
- **Remarketing** - allows us to personalize the content of the displayed ads.
- **Essential** - are important for the basic functionality of the site.

How to prevent the use of cookies?

Of course, you can refuse the use of cookies, simply by setting your Internet browser. You can enable, restrict or disable their use altogether. Instructions on how to set the use of cookie files in individual browsers can be found in the links below:
